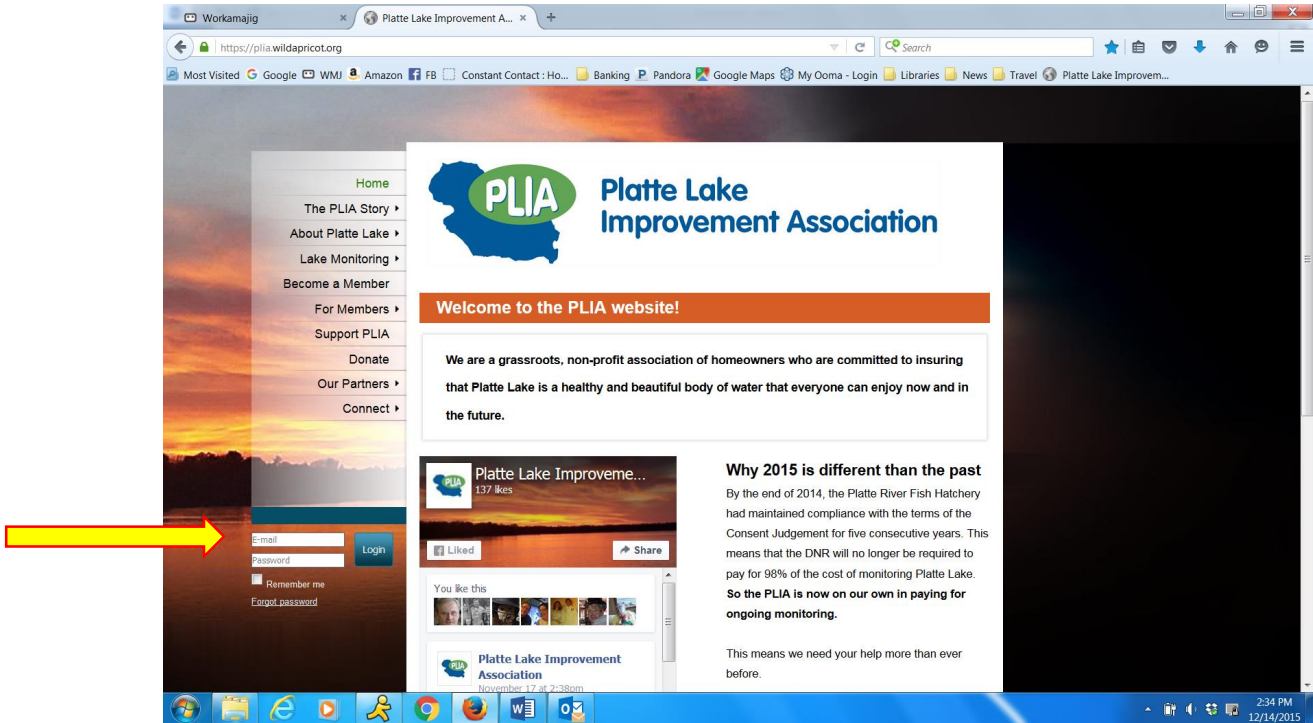


How to renew your PLIA membership on-line:

1. Log into our site [www. Plattelake.org](http://www.Plattelake.org). Your username is your email. If you don't know your password, click on forgot password and you'll get an email to reset it to something you can remember.



2. Click on view profile (this one's hard to see. It is just under your name.)



3. Change your membership level if you want, then click on renew



4. Then you'll get a screen where you can update your membership information to make sure our records are correct. When you've updated click on update

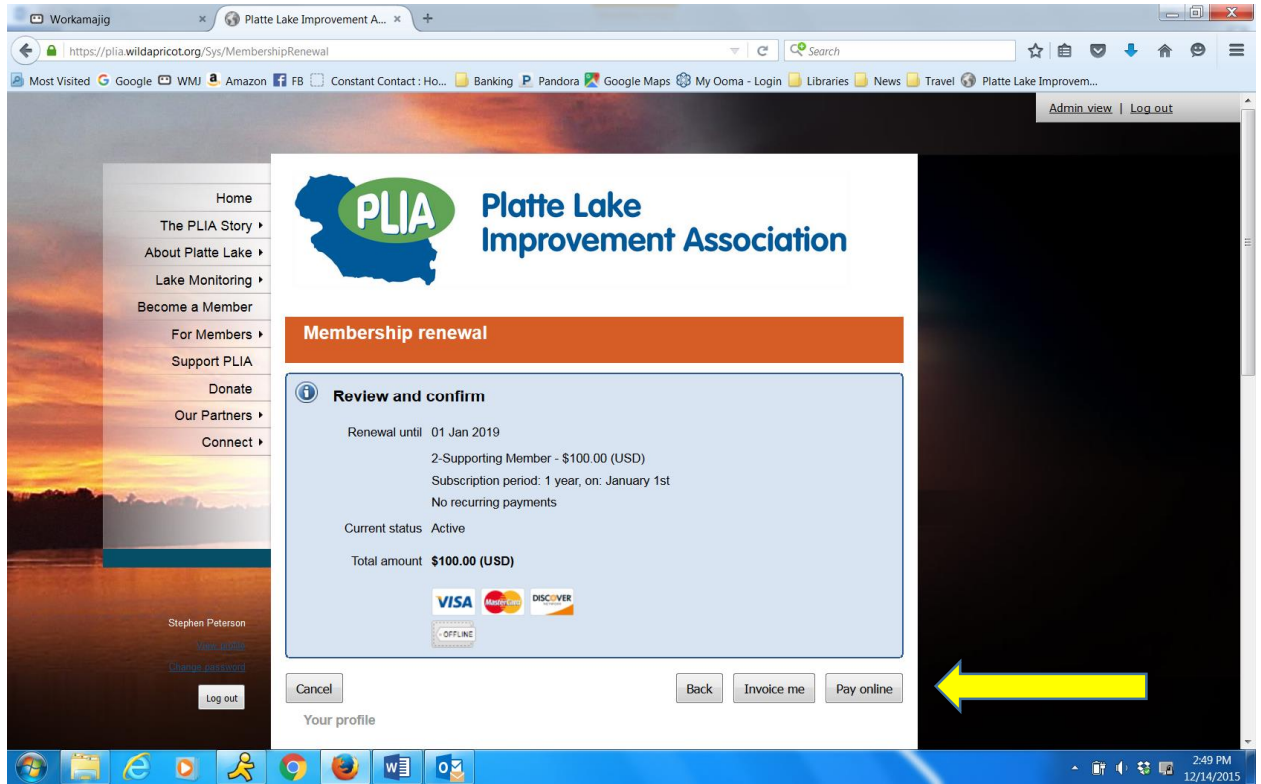
